Special Playing Rules and Other Information

- 1. Each team will be required to use the Drive of each of its players a minimum of two times over the course of the 18 holes.
- Senior Golfers (men 60 years or older) may use the Senior Tees if desired. Golfers with a handicap of 5 or less must use the Back Tees. All other (men) golfers will use the Main Tees. Women may use the forward most tees.
- 3. The maximum score on a hole is a bogey. If your foursome has not made par, pick-up and move to the next hole. If for any reason a hole is not played, you may score it as a bogey.
- 4. Closest to Pin: Women Hole #12
- 5. Closest to Pin: Men Hole #8
- 6. Longest Drive: Women Hole #11
- 7. Longest Drive: Men Hole #2
- 8. Lunch will follow immediately after play in the Dining Room.
- 9. After Lunch, we will award prizes to the winners as well as drawings for mulligan prices.
- 10. Remember to turn in your scorecard at the front desk.
